## **CONCRETE DONE!**

Concrete replacement and repair focused on safety issues. We replaced driveways and sidewalks that had severe trip hazards. Thanks much for everyone's cooperation during the process! We are asking all residents who got new concrete to water the areas where sod had to be peeled back to relocate the sprinkler heads. This would be very helpful and would save on resodding costs.



**Decks and Fences.** Several decks and fences have been repaired or replaced this Spring. Decks and fences in Buildings 6 and 9 are being repaired ahead of painting. Decks and fences in Buildings 3, 4 and 10 will also be repaired prior to painting in early FY 2019-20 (Fall 2019). Please trim shrubery away from fences and decks to preserve their longevity.



**TERMITES!** Yes, we have treated for termites in RFL this Spring. Check inside your garages for small mounds of sawdust type material. It's important to catch termites early! They can migrate up to 350 feet and like warm and moist places. Let us know if sprinklers are hitting your siding or fence.
